

JAPANESE CARS MEETING 2026

Misano World Circuit, 23-24 May 2026

REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

(to be signed and delivered in original at the entrance of the circuit)

1. The Meeting takes place inside the Misano World Circuit Area in Misano Adriatico (Rimini).
2. Entry to the Meeting is reserved exclusively for Japanese cars and motorcycles; the organizers reserve the right to deny registration to the event to any vehicles and/or participants who do not comply with the meeting regulations. Pedestrian visitor access is free.
3. Each vehicle participating in the Meeting will be assigned a specific "Park" space within the designated area. Unauthorized movement within the paddock is not permitted unless authorized by the Organizing Secretariat, except for the track day activities scheduled during the weekend.
4. Vehicle access to the Meeting area is allowed starting from 8:30 AM on Saturday, May 23rd, and only during the event hours and in the presence of the organizers of the Japanese Cars Meeting. Under no circumstances will access to the paddock be permitted after the end of the meeting or before it begins.
5. Vehicles must be in perfect condition and clean. There will be no equipped washing service station within the Meeting area.
6. Subject to compliance with the internal rules of the Misano Circuit and the general rules of individual and collective safety, participants will be allowed to leave their cars parked in the paddock overnight between Saturday and Sunday.
7. Participating vehicles must leave the Meeting at the end of the event and in any case no later than 8:00 PM on Sunday, May 24th.
8. At the time of registration at the Accreditation Center, before the start of the Meeting, the owner or driver of each registered vehicle will be given a sticker badge, which will serve as identification for entry.
9. All registered participants are strictly prohibited from carrying out promotional and/or advertising activities for their own commercial activities or on behalf of third parties. By way of example, but not limited to, promotional and/or advertising activities include: distributing flyers, promoting brands through advertising graphic material (flags, totems), distributing business cards, collecting contacts and searching for potential customers, etc. The organizers reserve the right to ensure compliance with this prohibition and to remove those who fail to respect it.
10. Each owner or driver will be solely responsible for their vehicle within the Meeting area. Participation in the event is at the participant's own risk, and the participant assumes all civil and criminal liability for any damage caused by themselves or their vehicle. By registering for the event, each participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Organizer and the Owner of the Circuit, as well as any of their representatives, appointees, officials, employees, or collaborators, from any and all liability for damages or inconveniences that may occur to them, to third parties, or to third-party property as a result of their participation in the event. The participant waives in advance any right of recourse and any appeal to authorities not recognized by current regulations. The participant further agrees, where applicable, to waive any claim or action against the Organizer, the Owner, and other involved parties for compensation for damages connected in any way to the participant's entry, presence, and/or use of the racetrack. This agreement becomes valid for the parties involved at the moment it is signed for acceptance.
11. Due to force majeure, the organization reserves the right to modify or suspend, in whole or in part, the program of the event.
12. For safety reasons, within the area set up for the Meeting, the use of open flames and sound amplification equipment is prohibited. The use of horns and acoustic devices is prohibited at any time (unless prior consent is given by the Organizing Secretariat). Any irresponsible or discourteous behavior by a participant may result in their removal from the Meeting. A monitoring service will supervise in order to protect the common interests.
13. These regulations must be signed for acceptance and submitted in original form before entering the Meeting area, at the time of check-in.
